Newfoundland & Labrador Colon Screening Program (NLCSP)

Target Population: Age 50-74

Individuals Who Qualify for FIT Testing:

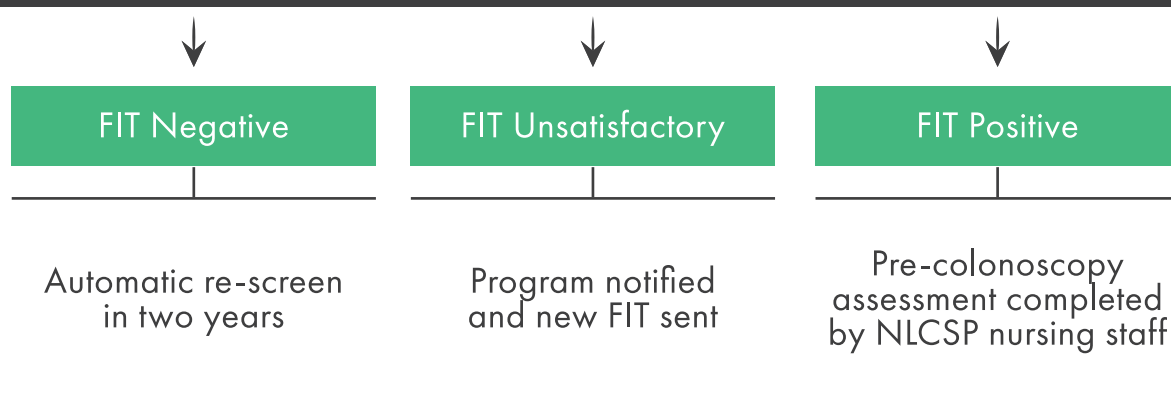
Asymptomatic with NO personal history of:

- 1) Colorectal Cancer (CRC), Inflammatory Bowel Disease or Adenomatous Polyps
- 2) 1st degree family member with CRC diagnosed before age 60
- 3) Two or more 1st degree family members diagnosed with CRC at any age
- 4) Colonoscopy in the last five years

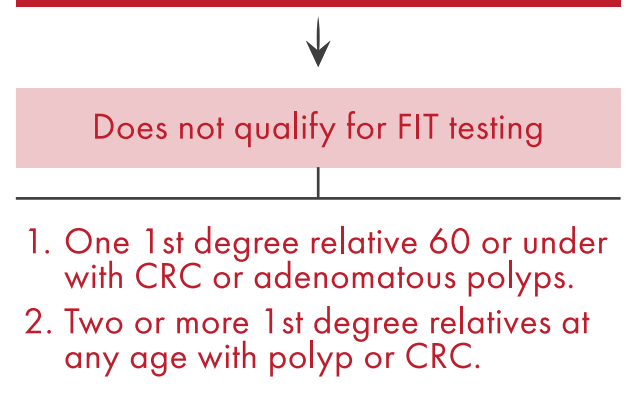
Individuals with a family history of colon cancer qualify for FIT if:

- 1) One 1st degree family member is over the age of 60
- 2) 2nd degree family members affected (aunts, uncles, grandparents)
- 3) 3rd degree family members affected (cousins, great-grandparents, etc.)

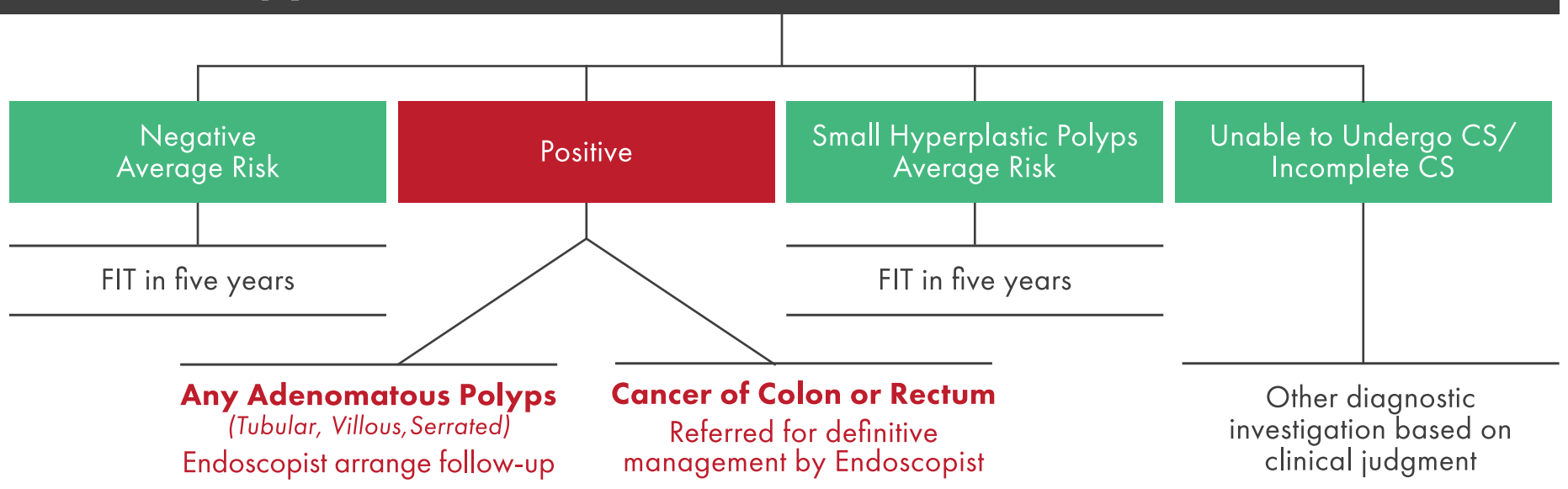
Fecal Immunochemical Test (FIT)

Specialist Care For:

- 1) Familial Adenomatous Polyposis (FAP) or Attenuated FAP
- 2) Hereditary Nonpolyposis Colorectal Cancer (HNPCC)/Lynch Syndrome
- 3) Inflammatory Bowel Disease
- 4) Other Identified Genetic Mutation
