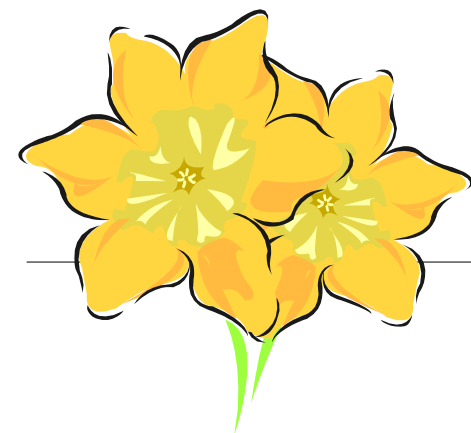

## Overview

The Canadian Cancer Society (CCS) provides a variety of services to help people living with cancer. One of our many support programs is the Volunteer Driving Program.

Through this program, the Canadian Cancer Society offers transportation to individuals with a cancer diagnosis who are based in the St. John's and the surrounding areas and require assistance with their transportation to and from their cancer-related appointments and treatments.



## Volunteer Driving Program

### Eligibility

To be eligible for the Volunteer Driving Program, you must meet the following criteria:

- Clients must be based in the St. John's and surrounding areas
- Clients must be able to get in and out of a car with minimal assistance or accompanied by a caregiver that will provide assistance
- Clients must be seeking drives for cancer-related appointments only
- Medical appointments are between Monday to Friday from 9:00am—4:00pm



### How the program works

If you qualify for the program, contact the Canadian Cancer Society—St. John's office to complete the registration process.

The Volunteer Driving Program Coordinator will contact a volunteer driver to make the arrangements for the transportation.



The volunteer driver will call you the evening before your scheduled appointment to confirm the details for the ride.

To arrange for a volunteer driver, a minimum of 48hrs notice is required and you must call Monday - Friday from 8:30am—4:30pm.
