

# **Radiation Therapy – Brain**

### **Radiation Treatment**

- Treatment is painless it is similar to getting an x-ray but with a higher energy to treat cancer.
- Each treatment takes about 15 minutes.
- You will need to lie still and breathe normally.

#### Possible Side Effects

Always discuss new side effects with your radiation oncology team.

#### Headaches

- Radiation can cause slight swelling in the brain which can cause headaches.
- You may be prescribed medication for pain or steroids to reduce the swelling.
- If you are taking steroids be sure to discuss your prescriptions and instructions for taking them once treatment is complete.
- If the headaches continue let a member of your healthcare team know.

#### Hair Loss

- Radiation can cause the hair in the treatment area to fall out.
- In most instances hair usually regrows 2-3 months after treatment.

#### Fatigue

- You may notice a decrease in energy level rest when needed.
- Eat a well-balanced diet and drink plenty of clear fluids.

#### Nausea, vomiting & lack of appetite

- You may be prescribed an anti-nausea or steroid medication if you experience this.
- Ask for a referral to a cancer clinic dietitian.
- Drink plenty of fluids, especially water
- Eat small, frequent meals.

#### Skin reaction

- The scalp may become dry and itchy.
- Limit hair washing to 2-3 times each week.
- Wash your hair and scalp gently don't scrub.
- Use an unscented baby shampoo.
- Avoid extreme temperatures to the area such as hair dryers & curling irons.
- Avoid hair products such as hair spray.
- Keep your head covered when outside by wearing a loose hat or scarf.

If you experience any of the following symptoms after the onset of radiation treatment, please visit your nearest emergency department:

- Severe nausea or vomiting
- Blurred or double vision
- Impaired hearing or speech
- Onset of headache
- Increase in existing headache
- Weakness in hands, arms, legs or feet
- Seizures

#### **Radiation Appointments**

Radiation treatments are scheduled Monday-Friday, except on holidays.

You will be scheduled for a *Radiation Review Appointment* weekly when you begin your treatments. At this appointment you may see a nurse, nurse practitioner, physician or radiation oncologist.
